

FSA ID



What's an FSA ID?

The FSA ID is a username and password combination you use to log in to U.S. Department of Education (ED) online systems. The FSA ID is your legal signature and shouldn't be created or used by anyone other than you not even your parent, your child, a school official, or a loan company representative. You'll use your FSA ID every year you fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form and for the lifetime of your federal student loans.

Click create account (pictured above)

Create Username and Password

- •Username can be anything you want
- •Password must meet the requirements and not have personal identifiers

Enter your personal info

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Social security #
- Address
- Email (Not a school issued email)
- •Cell Phone # (optional)

Create Security Question

- •Choose four questions to answer
- Answers cannot be the same and must be minimum three charaters long

Agree and Verify

- Verify the info is yours and correct
- Click on the email/phone boxes to be sent codes, to verify your account
