

- Central System for Virtual Principal Collaboration
- Intervention Groups to improve virtual attendance
- Focus on student connectedness and SEL





Collaboration with School Leaders

- Starting SEL with Middle
 School Principals

- One team in each building to identify student groups based on data





2020 SEL Pilot

- Initial results showed only 30% of students felt connected to adults
- Only 40% felt connected to anyone in the school






