

Key Changes – Text-to-Speech (TTS)

Specific to Wisconsin Forward Exam:


- **Text-to-Speech (TTS)** was previously an accommodation. Beginning with the Spring 24 administration, TTS is now a universal support available to all students taking the Forward Exam.
 - Staff do not need to assign TTS accommodation in the DRC INSIGHT Portal
 - **All students will now need headphones** during testing (unless tested individually in a separate setting).
 - In the Central Office Services (COS) Content Management configuration in the DRC INSIGHT Portal, **TTS must be selected** for the Forward Exam.



Key Changes (cont.) – Practice Test

Specific to Wisconsin Forward Exam:

- The **Practice Test** is new for Spring 24. It consolidates and replaces the former Online Tools Training (OTT) and Item Sampler applications.
- You may still see references to OTT and Item Sampler in standard DRC resources/documentation. For the Wisconsin Forward Exam, those terms mean the Practice Test.



What Has Changed and What Has Not

What Has Been Updated

- Supported operating systems – see System Requirements
- DRC INSIGHT Secure Applications updated to version 14.x
- Security updates released in June require admin rights to update Windows, MacOS devices
 - This change only applies to sites that manually update the browser on each machine after launching the DRC INSIGHT Secure Browser.
 - If your site uses deployment software for updates, you are unaffected since an Admin user handles the deployments.
 - Previously, users, including students, could initiate an update by clicking the Upgrade button on a device for sites that manually updated testing devices after launching the DRC INSIGHT Secure Browser.

What Has Changed and What Has Not (cont.)

What Has Been Updated – Cont.

- New URLs to be allowlisted – Listed in the Technology User Guide
- COS Service Device updated to version 7.x
 - Auto-updates, if left on overnight with an Internet connection
 - Or go into the COS Application to update manually

What Has Not Changed


- Supported Testing Device platforms – Windows, macOS, Linux, iPadOS and Chrome OS
- COS Service Device and testing device specifications
- Use the same COS Configurations and COS Org Unit ID


