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This Provider Manual gives instructions to Family Day Care Home sponsoring organizations on how to maintain their Provider List through DPI's online system. The Provider List is part of the sponsoring organization's CACFP contract with DPI. Sponsors must keep each Provider's File within their Provider List current by submitting updates for DPI approval.

If you have any questions on the Provider List process, contact your assigned consultant.

TERMS AND INFORMATION

Family Day Care Home (FDCH) Sponsoring Organization

A FDCH sponsoring organization is an agency that has a contract with DPI to sponsor FDCH providers for CACFP participation. They are referred to as the “sponsor” throughout this manual.

FDCH Provider

A FDCH provider is either licensed or certified to provide child care by the Department of Child and Family Services (DCF). They may also be referred to as the “provider”, “home provider”, or “family day care home” throughout this manual.

Provider List

The Provider List, formerly known as “Schedule A”, is the sponsor’s list of providers with whom the agency has active *CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreements* and are approved by DPI for CACFP participation under their sponsorship. It is part of the sponsor’s CACFP contract with DPI. Providers must be approved on the sponsor’s Provider List to claim them for reimbursement. Sponsors must keep information current in each Provider Application by submitting updates for DPI approval.

DPI uses the Provider List information to complete monitoring ratio analyses for determining the sponsor’s compliance with the monitoring ratio requirements. Infrequent removal of terminated providers from the sponsor’s Provider List may inflate the required number of monitoring hours.

Printing: If printing any of the webpages, use landscape to capture the information on one page.

Obtaining an Excel or PDF copy of the Provider List: Contact your [DPI consultant](#) for an Excel or PDF copy of the sponsor’s Provider List. Terminated providers may be included upon request by specifying how many months back.

CACFP Home Provider Application Form

The [CACFP Home Provider Application Form](#) is a required DPI form sponsors must complete for each new provider during the enrollment process from which information must be entered into each Provider’s File.

Sponsors may either use the electronic pdf-fillable version posted to DPI’s webpage or DPI’s 2-ply hard copies.

➤ Contact your [DPI consultant](#) for copies of the 2-ply hard copies, as needed.

Provider Application

The “Provider Application” is referred to as the “Provider File”.

The Provider File is the online file for each provider where the sponsor enters information initially from the provider’s completed [CACFP Home Provider Application Form](#) and regulation. Once a new provider is approved by DPI on the sponsor’s Provider List, the sponsor must submit updates to the Provider’s File to reflect any changes.

Guidance Memorandum (GM) A – Provider Eligibility

[GMA](#) provides further information on all the terms referenced in this manual.

PROVIDER FILE INFORMATION

Each provider must have a [Provider File](#) within the sponsor's [Provider List](#). Each Provider's File must contain required information in each of the three following sections:

- [Provider Information](#)
- [Regulation Information](#)
- [Approved CACFP Participation Period](#)

Provider Information Section

Provider Number

It is a unique number assigned by the sponsor to each provider which is used both within the sponsor's administrative software and DPI's online Provider Files.

- A provider number must never be re-used by assigning it to another provider.
- When providers return to participate under a former sponsor, the sponsor should use the same, previously assigned provider number. See [below](#) for instructions on how to reactivate a provider number.

The following information is printed on the provider's regulation and must be entered into the Provider File:

DWD Provider Number

It is referred to as a "Provider Number" and typically printed on the **bottom left corner** of the regulation.

This Provider Number has 13 digits. The last 3 digits is the location number and typically changes when a provider moves.

Provider Information Section Cont'd

First Name / Last Name

Must be as printed on the regulation.

If there is a middle initial, list it in the First Name field with a space before it, e.g., "Lilly K."

Date of Birth

The provider's 'Date of Birth' must be entered in this field.

Street Address

Must be the street address where the licensed or certified home is located, as printed on the regulation.

Different Mailing Address:

If the provider has a different mailing address from the home's location, it is optional to list it in the field below the street address field.

If listing a different mailing address, make sure to include the street address, city, and zip code.

➤ **The street address or mailing address must not be a P.O. Box.**

City and Zip

Must be where the home is located, as printed on the regulation. It is optional to include the four-digit zip code extension.

County

Select the County where the home is located using the dropdown arrow.

Press the dropdown arrow using the mouse and select the respective county to fill in this field. (You may type the first letter of the county to filter your search.)

Provider's Phone Number and Email Address

DPI does not collect this information within the Provider Files and will request for it from the sponsor if needed.

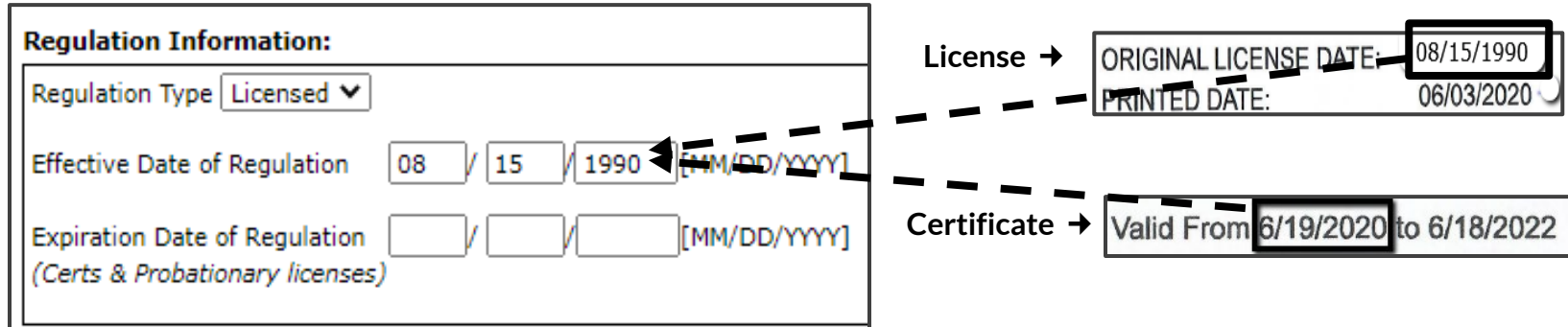

Effective Date of Regulation

This date is the Original License Date printed on a license and the start date of the validity period printed on a certificate.



When to Update the Effective Date of Regulation Field:

- DO NOT CHANGE the Effective Date of Regulation unless the provider is issued a completely new regulation.

Lapse in Regulation

Sometimes an existing provider’s regulation may lapse between renewals, when the provider moves, or they temporarily close.

- **DO NOT CHANGE** the *Effective Date of Regulation* in the provider’s file. Leave it as is **unless the provider is issued a completely new regulation.**

The sponsor must assure that the provider is not paid for any meals during a lapse in regulation within the sponsor’s claim system.

[Regulation Information Section Cont'd](#)

Expiration Date of Regulation

Only probationary licenses and certificates have expiration dates. Expiration dates are not printed on regular licenses (also referred to as non-expiring). Below are examples:

When and How to Update the Expiration Date of Regulation Field

Licenses

- When a provider’s probationary license is updated to a regular license (*the expiration date has been removed from the license*), a “non-expiring” license, remove the date from the *Expiration Date of Regulation* and leave the field blank.
- If the license’s probationary period has been extended (*a new expiration date has been printed on the license and it is still labeled as “Probationary”*), enter the new expiration date.

Certificates (always have expiration dates)

- When the expiration date has been extended on the provider’s updated certificate, enter the new expiration date.

Regulation Information Section Cont'd

The sponsor does not enter the following regulation information into the Provider File for DPI approval.

- Capacity
- Days of operation
- Hours of operation
- Months of operation
- Ages served
- Any DCF exceptions to the above that affect meal eligibility (For example, lower capacity during evening hours)

Sponsors must accurately maintain this information for each provider in their administrative software system as it affects the provider's claiming eligibility. For example, providers must only be reimbursed for meal types served during the hours of operation approved on their regulation.

All the above information from the provider's regulation and meal types and meal service times must be initially approved by the sponsor on their [CACFP Home Provider Application Form](#). Sponsors must monitor and approve subsequent changes based on updates to the provider's regulation information and the provider's request for meal type and meal service time changes.

Refer to [GMA - Provider Eligibility](#) for more information on approval of meal types and meal service times.

DPI reviews the accuracy of the sponsor's maintenance of this information within their software systems during administrative reviews.

Approved CACFP Participation Period

Effective Date of Agreement

Subject to DPI's approval, the *Effective Date of Agreement* is the official date on which a new provider may begin claiming meals for CACFP reimbursement. This date must be listed on the *CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement*, *CACFP Home Provider Application Form*, and Provider's File approved within the sponsor's Provider List.

- Sponsors must enter this date in the *Effective Date of Agreement* field of a new Provider's File.

It must be **the latest of the three following dates, unless otherwise approved by DPI:**

- Effective date printed on the provider's regulation;
- Pre-visit date; or
- Orientation date

Approved CACFP Participation Period Cont'd

DPI Approved Effective Date of Agreement

DPI will approve the sponsor's *Effective Date of Agreement* if the sponsor's submission date of the new Provider's File is no later than the end of the next calendar month.

Example: - Sponsor's *Effective Date of Agreement* is December 15th
- Sponsor submits new provider application on January 10th
- DPI approves December 15th as the *Effective Date of Agreement*

If the sponsor submits the new Provider's File **after the end of the next calendar month**, DPI must approve the *Effective Date of Agreement* **no earlier than the 1st day of the calendar month preceding the submission date.**

Example: - Sponsor's *Effective Date of Agreement* is December 15th
- Sponsor submits new provider application on February 5th
- DPI approves January 1st as the *Effective Date of Agreement*

- If DPI cannot approve the *Effective Date of Agreement* the sponsor had submitted in the new Provider's File, **the sponsor will need to change this date to DPI's approved *Effective Date of Agreement* within the Provider's File** (as well as on the CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement and CACFP Home Provider Application before sending the sponsor's approved copies to the provider.).

DO NOT CHANGE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF AGREEMENT once DPI approves them to begin participation as a new provider. It must remain unchanged for the duration of the provider's participation under your sponsorship, regardless of updates to their regulation.

- **Sponsors must not submit new providers within their reimbursement claim until DPI has approved them within the sponsor's Provider List.**

Sponsor's Termination Date

Updating the Sponsor's Termination Date Field:

- If this field has a date and the provider is still participating, delete the date and leave the field blank.
- Leave the field blank until the sponsor has terminated the provider. Go to the [Terminating or Removing a Provider File](#) section for more information.

When terminating a provider from their sponsorship, sponsors must enter their termination date into the Sponsor's Termination Date field and submit the file to DPI to remove the provider from their Provider List.

Once DPI approves the termination, the sponsor will no longer be able to view the provider's file within their Provider List.

The Termination Date entered in this field depends on whether the provider is terminated For Convenience or For Cause.

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- The Termination Date for Providers Terminated For Convenience: The Termination Date is the last date of claimed meals for which CACFP reimbursement was paid to the provider whose *CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement* has terminated.
- The Termination Date for providers terminated For Cause: The Termination Date is the date of the issued Termination & Disqualification letter. Follow [DPI's Serious Deficiency Procedures](#) found under [GM M - Serious Deficiency Requirements](#).

Refer to [GM A - Provider Eligibility](#), the *Termination* section, for further information on the definitions of "For Convenience" and "For Cause".

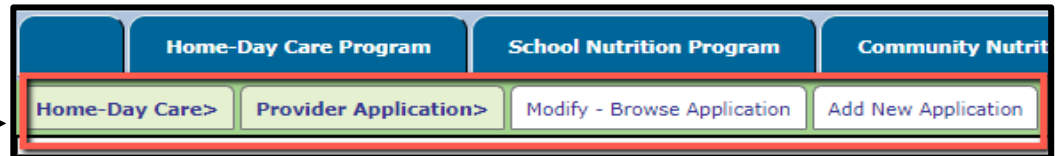

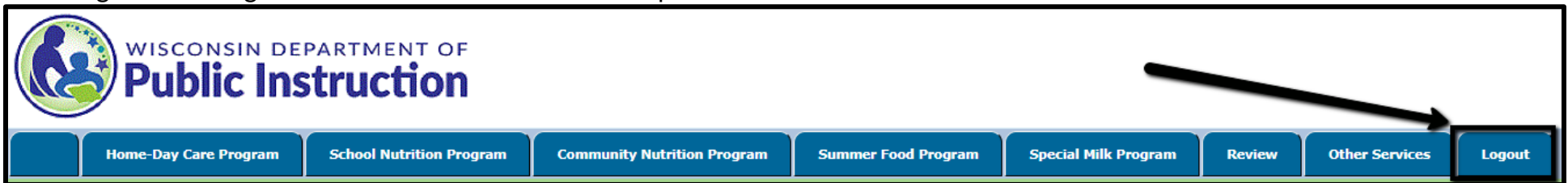
Tabs to Navigate

Time Limitations

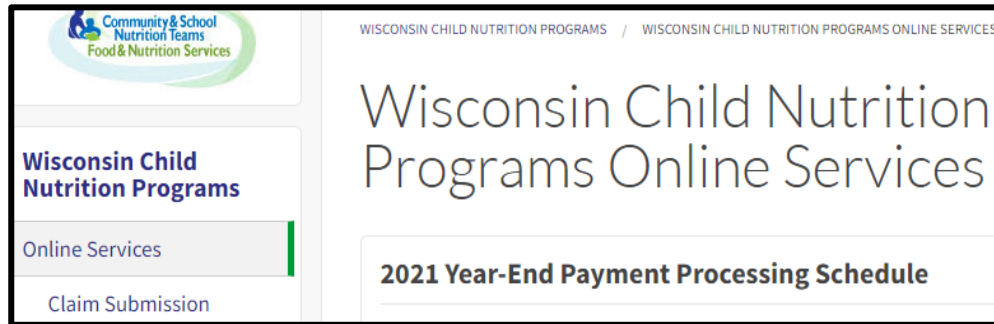
A timer starts from the moment the website is entered. If there is no activity for 30 minutes, the user will get an error message and will have to return to the main 'Login' screen. **Any data on the page you were working will not be saved.** Any movement on a page, such as going from one screen to another or moving to another entry field on the same page, will reset the 30-minute timer.

DPI's Database

All submitted Provider File information reaches DPI's database instantly, where it is then stored in a temporary file until approved by the sponsor's [DPI consultant](#).

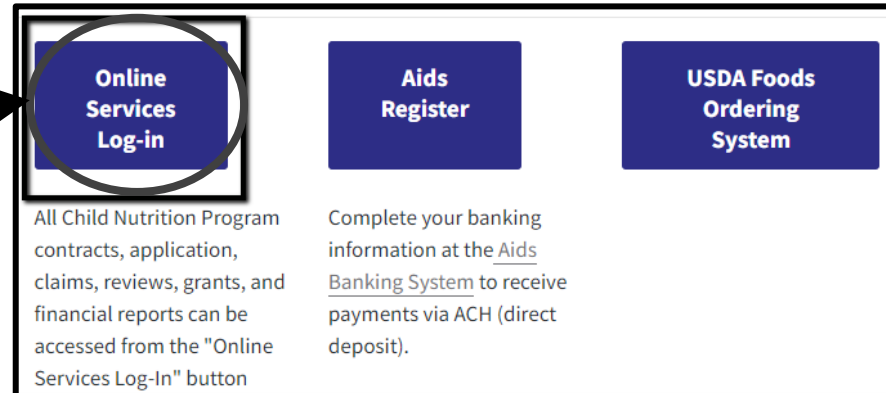

Updating an Existing Provider File

1. Select the 'Modify-Browse Application' Tab.

The 'Modify - Browse Application' tab takes you to the *Search - Modify Existing Applications* page or the search criteria box.

Using the Search Criteria Box

All the following search criteria will list providers in both "Open" and "Filed" application status.

- **"Show All Providers", "Show Licensed Providers" and "Show Certified Providers":**

The search results list providers in provider number order when using these three criteria.

- **"Show by Provider Number":**

The search results list one provider.

Use this criterion to find an existing provider most quickly.

A provider may have two Provider Files (*with the same provider number*), one for a license and the other a certificate. Since the Department of Children and Families (DCF) no longer allows providers to operate under both regulation types at the same time, the two Provider Files should only appear on the *Provider Application Based on Search-List of Application* page when the sponsor is transitioning a Provider File from one regulation to the other (from license to certificate OR certificate to license). Go to the [Changes to Regulation Type](#) section for further information.

- **"Show by First Name" and "Show by Last Name":** The search results list providers in alphabetical order by first name if searching by first name and respectively by last name.
 - Searches are not case sensitive;
 - Enter at least one letter before clicking 'SEARCH'.
- **"Show Modified/New Application":** Go to the explanation for [this search criteria](#) in the [Adding a New Provider File](#) section.

2. Select any one of the criteria to find specific existing Provider Files, then click 'SEARCH'.

Upon clicking 'SEARCH' on the *Search - Modify Existing Applications* page, you will go to the *Provider Application(s) Based on Search - List of Application* page.

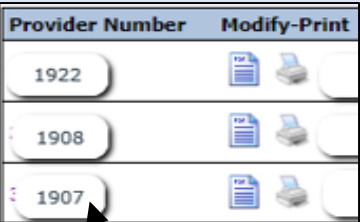

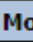

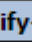
The chart below explains the link options for opening a Provider File.

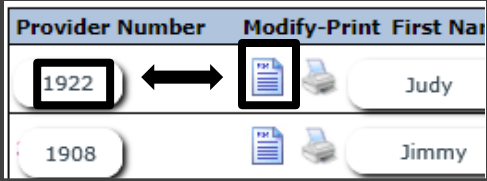

Selecting 'Back' returns you to the *Provider List* and does not save any changes nor submits the Provider File to DPI for approval.

Clicking on the **Printer icon**  under 'Modify-Print' only allows you to **view the Provider File**. At the bottom of the screen, you can only click on: **[Back To List]** to return back to the Provider List.

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Updating an Existing Provider File Cont'd

The **Contract Effective Date** is [DPI's Approved Effective Date of Agreement](#) and must be the same date entered in the [Effective Date of Agreement](#) field by the sponsor.

Application Status indicates whether DPI has approved a submitted Provider File (either updated existing provider or new provider).

- **“Open”** means the submitted Provider File has not yet been approved by DPI.
- **“Filed”** means the Provider File has been approved by DPI.

Once the Provider File is open, the provider's information will appear on the *Modify Application* page.

4. Make the needed updates to the provider's information on the *Modify Application* page.
 - Go to the [Provider Information](#) section for the required information that must be kept current in the Provider Files.

5. Update the 'Preparer Name and Phone No.' information, as needed:

6. Click 'SAVE'.

Clicking 'SAVE' will "save" the updated information and submit the Provider's File to DPI for approval.

You will then return to the *Provider Application Based on Search - List of Application* page.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the information on this application is true and correct. Reimbursement will be claimed only for meals served to children who are enrolled and receiving child care services. I understand that information on this application is being given in connection with the receipt of federal funds and deliberate misrepresentation may subject me to prosecution under applicable state and federal statutes. The program must be available to all eligible children regardless of age, sex, disability, race, color or national.

1. To claim reimbursement for provider's own children, an approved, current Household Size-Income Statement must be file with the sponsor.
2. Reimbursement may be made only for meals approved by DPI and the sponsoring organization.
3. Two hours between meals is recommended.
4. Provider claiming shifts meals must submit to the sponsor current meal shift schedule(s) with each month.

- If you click 'BACK' instead of 'SAVE', updated information will not be saved and the Provider's File will not be submitted for DPI approval.

Continue submitting Provider File updates by following steps 2-6 above.

Updating an Existing Provider File Cont'd

The 'Application Status' will change to **"Open"** on the *Provider Application Based on Search-List of Applications* page.

Updates to Provider Files of currently participating providers are considered effective upon the sponsor's submission and are not contingent on the sponsor's submission date for DPI approval as are Provider Files for new providers. Refer to the [Effective Date of Agreement](#) terms in the [Provider File – Approved CACFP Participation Period](#) section for DPI approval contingencies.

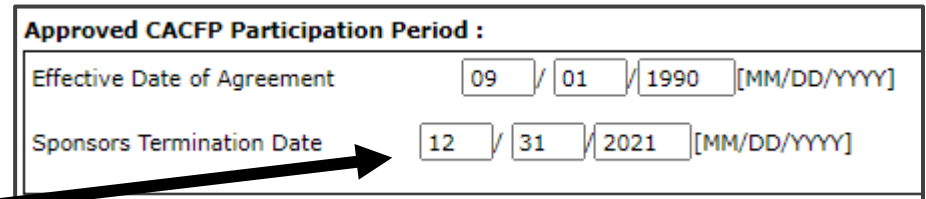
7. Email your [consultant](#) the updated regulations for submitted providers in PDF format.
 - **Name each provider's regulation in the following format: 'Firstname Lastname provider number.pdf'**

Once DPI approves the submitted Provider File, the 'Application Status' will change to **"Filed"**.

Terminating or Removing a Provider File

To remove a terminated provider from the sponsor's Provider List:

1. Select the 'Modify-Browse Application' Tab.
2. Using the instructions in the [Using the Search Criteria](#) section of this manual, select the "Show by Provider Number" from the search criteria. Enter the provider number.
3. In the [Approved CACFP Participation Period](#) section of the *Modify Application* page:
 - Enter the last date of claimed meals for which CACFP reimbursement was paid to the provider in the [Sponsor's Termination Date](#) field.
4. Click 'SAVE'.
5. Email your [consultant](#) about the providers submitted for termination or removal.

Once DPI approves the termination, the sponsor will no longer be able to view the provider's file within their Provider List.

The [Sponsor's Termination Date](#) section explains the difference between For Convenience and For Cause termination dates.

Terminating a Provider listed on the DCF's Closed Facilities Report

DPI downloads DCF's Closed Facility Report each month showing facilities with closed regulations and then notifies the sponsor of any of their providers listed on the report.

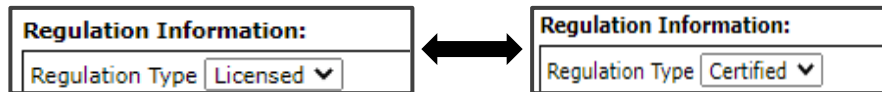
NOTE: This report is a "snapshot in time" and may not include all facilities depending on whether DCF has entered the closure date into their system upon DPI's download of the report. Sponsors are to not solely rely on this report for information on their provider's facility closures.

Provider Manual for Family Day Care Home Sponsoring Organizations

When notified by DPI or DCF of a provider whose regulation closed, **the sponsor must do the following:**

1. Immediately terminate the provider within their own system effective DCF's closure date;
 - Refer to [GM M - Serious Deficiency Requirements](#) for providers revoked for imminent threat to health and safety reasons.
2. Update the Provider File by entering the closure date into **both the 'Expiration Date of Regulation' and 'Sponsors' Termination Date' fields.**

Change in Provider's Regulation Type



The regulation type (licensed or certified) selected within the provider file cannot be changed.

If the provider changes their type of regulation from certified to licensed or licensed to certified, the terminated regulation must be removed from the sponsor's Provider List and a Provider File for the new or re-instated regulation type must be submitted for DPI approval.

1. Remove the terminated regulation.
 - A. Select the 'Modify-Browse Application' Tab;
 - B. Select the "Show by Provider Number" from the search criteria (*illustrated on the [Using the Search Criteria](#) section of this manual.*) Enter the provider number.
 - C. On the *Modify Application* page:
 - (1) Make note of the following information to enter in the Provider File for the new or re-instated regulation type:
 - Date of Birth
 - Effective Date of Agreement
 - (2) Enter the last date of claimed meals for which CACFP reimbursement was paid to the provider under this regulation.
2. Add a new Provider File if it is a new regulation type or update the reactivated regulation type if it is a previously existing, re-instated regulation.
 - In either case, the Provider File must have the same provider number, the provider's date of birth, and the Effective Date of Agreement listed in the Provider File for the terminated regulation.
 - To submit a new Provider File for a new regulation, follow the steps in the [Adding a New Provider](#) section.
 - To submit an updated Provider File for a previously existing, re-instated regulation, follow the steps in the [Returning Providers and Re-instated Regulation Types](#) section.

Provider Manual for Family Day Care Home Sponsoring Organizations

Dual Regulations

The Department of Children and Families (DCF) no longer issues both a license and a certificate to providers. However, if DCF makes an exception to this rule and the provider is going to claim meals under both regulation types, they must have two Provider Files in the sponsor's Provider List, one for each regulation type.

Returning Providers and Re-instated Regulation Types

When the sponsor terminates a Provider File from their Provider List, they can no longer view that Provider File or update its information.

Reactivating a Terminated Provider

- **Provider's lapse is less than a 12-month period:**

Depending on the sponsor's assessment of the provider's capability in maintaining Program compliance, the sponsor may either re-enroll them by following the new provider enrollment process (*of completing an orientation and a previsit as well as a new CACFP Home Provider Application Form and CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement*) OR resume the provider's former CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement.

- **Provider's lapse is 12-months or more:**

The sponsor must re-enroll the provider by following the new provider enrollment process.

To re-activate a provider within the sponsor's Provider List for DPI approval to resume participation, the sponsor must:

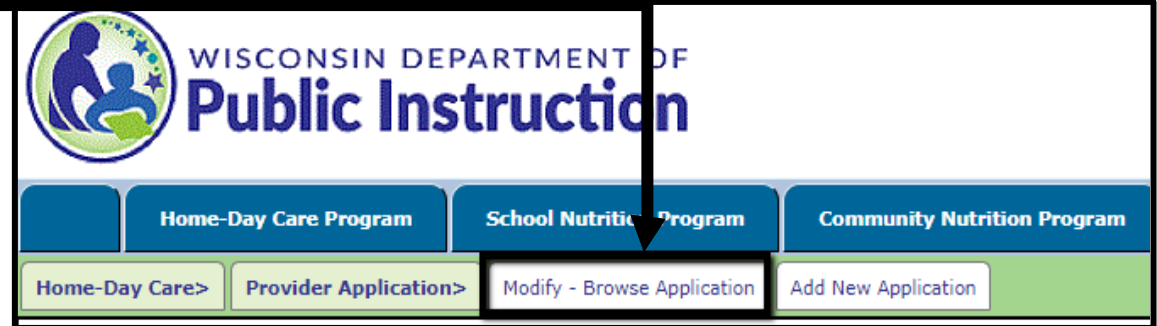
1. Assign the same [Provider Number](#) in the sponsor's system as was used for their previous participation;
2. Contact their [DPI consultant](#) to request the provider number be reactivated;
3. Once DPI removes the termination date, it will then be an existing Provider File. Access, modify, and submit the now existing Provider File for DPI approval.
 - If re-enrolling a provider whose lapse is less than 12 months **under their former CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement**, the sponsor must update the Provider File by modifying the [Regulation Information](#) as needed and the Sponsor's [Approved CACFP Participation Period](#) by not changing the 'Effective Date of Agreement' and removing the date from the 'Sponsors Termination Date' field to leave it blank.
 - If re-enrolling a provider whose lapse was 12 months or more OR less than 12 months if deemed as needing an orientation, previsit, and new CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement, then the sponsor must update the Provider File by modifying the [Regulation Information](#) as needed and the Sponsor's [Approved CACFP Participation Period](#) by changing the 'Effective Date of Agreement' to the new one approved on their new CACFP Sponsor-Home Provider Agreement and removing the date from the 'Sponsors Termination Date' field to leave it blank.

Reactivating a Provider File for a Re-instated Regulation Type

If a currently participating provider's lapsed regulation is re-instated, the sponsor must contact their [DPI consultant](#) to request the provider's re-instated regulation be reactivated. Once DPI removes the termination date from the Provider File, the sponsor will be able to access, update, and submit it for DPI approval. They must update the [Regulation Information](#) as applicable and the Sponsor's [Approved CACFP Participation Period](#) by not changing the 'Effective Date of Agreement' and removing the date from the 'Sponsors Termination Date' field to leave it blank.

Browsing Provider Files

1. Select the 'Modify-Browse Application' tab.

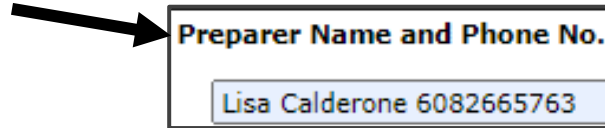

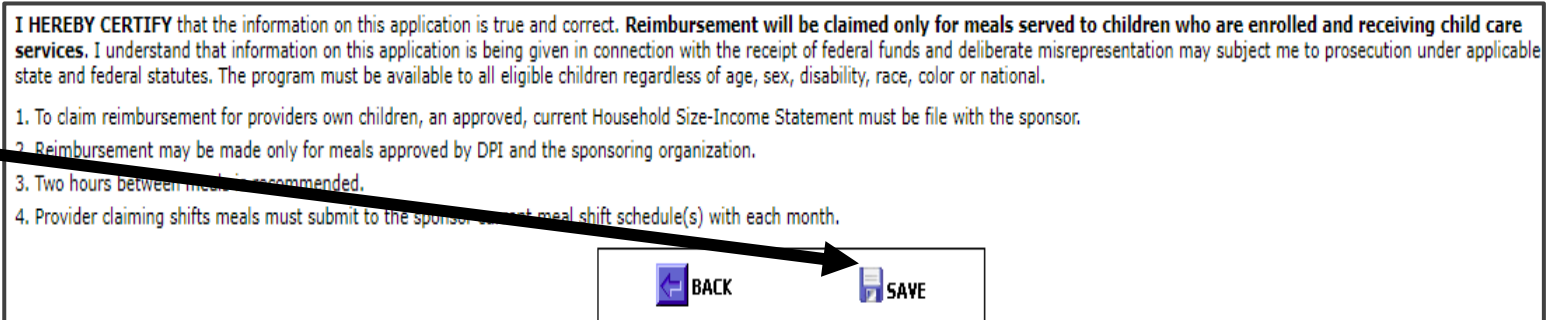

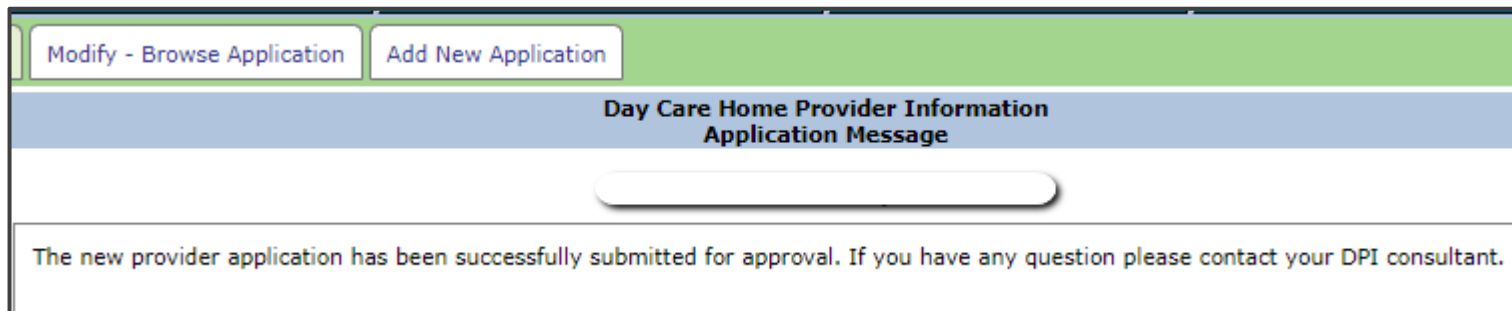

 - Write the [provider number](#) on the regulation before scanning it.
 - Save the regulation with file name in the following format: '**Firstname Lastname provider number.pdf**'.
 - B. Include the following documents with a copy of the provider's regulation, if applicable:
 - The DCF Letter of Transmittal or print-out from the DCF website confirming that the provider's regulation is issued in their name **only if the name of the facility is listed on the regulation instead of the provider's name.**
(Refer to [GMA - Provider Eligibility](#), the *Provider's Regulation* section, for further situations that may require additional documentation or follow up with the provider before they may begin participation.)
 - A fully completed [Home Provider-Sponsor Transfer Request form](#) if the provider is transferring from another sponsor to participate under your agency's sponsorship.
