**Excessive Heat** 

USDA will not be issuing a separate Excessive Heat Waiver this summer. They have clarified that the current Nationwide Waiver to Allow Non-Congregate Feeding for Summer 2022 Operations – EXTENSION 7 is intended to be utilized broadly, including instances where a sponsor may wish to allow children to take meals off site due to excessive heat, air quality or other exceptional circumstances. It will NOT be required that you document weather advisories to use the waiver. To use these flexibilities, SFSP sponsors must follow the instructions provided below.

### **How to Apply for the Waivers and Operational Requirements** When Using Them

Sponsor are not required to utilize the waivers, but if elect to do so, must:

- 1. Complete the SFSP 2022 Waiver Request Form all waivers listed, with the exception of the area eligibility waiver. The area eligibility waiver is not included in the waiver request form..
- 2. Update the SFSP Application following the instructions provided within the Site Application and Operational Requirements Under Summer 2022 SFSP Waivers document.
- 3. Provide any further information requested by DPI regarding the use the waivers for reporting purposes to USDA.

Sponsors that have utilized the waivers in the past, may use the forms for meal counting, parent/guardian pick up signage, etc. that have been used in previous years. Sponsors electing to use these waivers that have not used them in the past will be contacted by DPI to discuss requirements and provide resources to ensure requirements are met.
