Event Description

Under Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), the number of students who may take the alternate assessment is limited to no more than 1 percent of the total of all students in the state who are assessed in a given subject. States are required to seek a waiver of this cap if anticipated that the state will exceed the 1 percent cap. The department anticipates the cap will be exceeded for the 2017-18 school year and is requesting a waiver from the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education. The department is seeking public input as part of this process.
