Student Placement Dispute Form

A homeless child or youth has the right to remain at his or her school of origin (public school that the child or youth attended when permanently housed, or the public school in which the child or youth was last enrolled) or to attend any public school that other students who live in the attendance area are eligible to attend.

When a dispute arises over school placement, this form is to be completed by the parent/caregiver or unaccompanied youth. Student Placement Dispute Process

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When a dispute arises over school placement the Homeless Coordinator, in consultation with the parent/caregiver or unaccompanied youth, will complete a student placement dispute form. A Homeless Coordinator can be contacted at (414) 475-8911. The Homeless Coordinator will submit the dispute form to the Homeless Liaison. The Homeless Liaison will make a determination and send the disputant a copy of the *Written Notification of Dispute Resolution* form. The student has the right to attend the school of choice until the dispute is resolved.



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
