

# NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVIEW ACADEMIC STANDARDS

On January 24, 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction will start a review of academic standards in Literacy in All Subjects. To ensure that Wisconsin Academic Standards prepare all students to be college and career ready, these standards represent the common skills, knowledge, and dispositions that are necessary for students to succeed. Wisconsin Academic Standards are reviewed, revised, or both on an ongoing basis, and their adoption and use by schools is voluntary in state statute.
